At the NKC Meeting held 21st, 22nd and 23rd Of August, 2009, the following was approved and is now applicable.

Chapter 6 - Rule 6.23

Amendment to read:

WARNING (NOT A PENALTY)

6.23 Any competitors under the age of 18 years who are called before a Clerk of the Course or Steward for a verbal or written warning must be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian before being addressed by an AKA Official.

A steward may, if no complaint has been made concerning an incident, verbally warn a person subject to these rules, and may make a notation to that effect in the person's log book. The steward must first advise the person what offence the steward believes the person has committed and must give the person an opportunity to provide an explanation. If a complaint is subsequently made concerning the incident which resulted in the warning, a hearing must be held. If a stewards' hearing is held, and the complaint proven, the notification of the warning in the log book may be cancelled. If the complaint is dismissed the notation in the logbook must be cancelled.
