All class weights as per the 2009 WA State Rules and the 2009 AKA Karting Manual. .

Enclosed shoes must be worn in the Pit and Grid Area.

No dogs, no scooters or no bikes are allowed at the track.

Head sealing nuts must be fitted to engines as per rule 19.33. When engine seals are issued, competitor is to fit them, but you must leave the tail at full length.

Restrictors (Midgets/Rookies) will be sealed. Must have nut fitted on exhaust as per AKA Karting Manual 2009 Rule 41.27(Midgets) and Rule 40.06(Rookies).
