ADDENDUM No. 12

Issued: 17th February 2011

At the NKC meeting held on the 12th /13th February the following were approved and are effective immediately.

Chapter 22:

1. Change of rule reference in rule 22.02

22.02 Random Samples:

Randomly selected competitior(s) may have a sample of their fuel or lubricant taken and sealed for later laboratory analysis. If the fuel is found not to comply a complaint shall be made to the State Tribunal Registrar by the Fuel Tester under Rule 7.04(o) and the competitor(s) shall be subsequently charged with an offence under Rule 5.01(q). The cost of such testing shall be borne by the promoting club or otherwise agreed.

2. Amendment the last sentence in rule 22.03.7 to read:

22.03.7 Control Fuel

Promoters of major events may state the details and availability of a control fuel. These details must be on approved Supplementary Regulations for the event and will automatically constitute the designated fuel for that meeting. A control fuel cannot be a fuel, which is not an approved fuel. The control fuel at the National Championships for Formula 100 may be ELF Euro 102.
