ADDENDUM No. 4

Issued: 17th February 2011

At the NKC meeting held on the 12th /13th February the following were approved and are effective immediately.

1. Addition to rule 23.03.1

23.03 Tyre Treatment:

1. It is not permissible to tamper with any tyre, to alter its hardness, construction or composition with any method or agent including the use of an electric heat gun. **It is highly recommended that any solvent based lubricants to aid fitting of tyres, not be used.**

2. Addition to rule 23.03 f)

- f) **If chemical treatment of tyres is suspected, after sampling, tyres/wheels will be impounded between events during the meeting.**

At the completion of the meeting, tyres will be impounded, bagged, sealed and tagged and sent to the State Technical Officer/Coordinator for final testing. The competitor or their representative has the right to be present for final testing with the State Technical Officer/Coordinator.

If chemical treatment of tyres is established as per rule 23.03 c d & e above, competitor will be excluded from the race meeting and their licence fully suspended for 12 months. This decision and penalty is non-appealable.
