ADDENDUM No. 4

Issued: 17th February 2011

At the NKC meeting held on the 12th /13th February the following were approved and are effective immediately.

1. Addition to rule 23.03.1

23.03 Tyre Treatment:

- 1. It is not permissible to tamper with any tyre, to alter its hardness, construction or composition with any method or agent including the use of an electric heat gun. It is highly recommended that any solvent based lubricants to aid fitting of tyres, not be used.
- 2. Addition to rule 23.03 f)
 - f) If chemical treatment of tyres is suspected, after sampling, tyres/wheels will be impounded between events during the meeting.

At the completion of the meeting, tyres will be impounded, bagged, sealed and tagged and sent to the State Technical Officer/Coordinator for final testing. The competitor or their representative has the right to be present for final testing with the State Technical Officer/Coordinator.

If chemical treatment of tyres is established as per rule 23.03 c d & e above, competitor will be excluded from the race meeting and their licence fully suspended for 12 months. This decision and penalty is non-appealable.
