ADDENDUM No. 4

Issued: 18th February, 2013

At the NKC meeting held on the 16th and 17th February, 2013, the following was approved and is effective immediately.

1. Change to rule 16.05(c) 1).

16.05(c) 1). Timed qualifying Sessions:

For events or specific races that require timed qualifying to determine grid positions (other than State or National Championship events), the organizers may program a minimum of one or a maximum of two timed qualifying sessions per class. Each programmed timed qualifying session must allow competitors a reasonable time to complete a minimum of three (3) timed laps and shall be no more than ten (10) minutes in duration.

2. Change to rule 16.05(d) 1) to read;

16.05(d) 1) Technical Infringement During an Event:

When a competitor fails to record a time during timed qualifying for any reason other than through the fault of the organizers, the driver will be issued a time of the slowest lap time from that class, plus one second. Action will be taken by the issue of a Penalty Notification Form, which will be issued without an Officials Hearing and signed by at least one Steward and the Chief Timing Officer (Judge of Fact).

A complaint / appeal cannot be lodged against this action.
