CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Championship and Feature classes eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A or B
 Grade AKA licence. New Zealand competitors as per AKA manual and Trans Tasman license
 agreement.
- Support classes eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade AKA licence.
- D grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter.
- Entries for Formula Junior Max must hold a minimum of an unrestricted B Grade Junior Licence.
- Refusal or acceptance of entries as per rule 1.15.
- The Race Secretary reserves the right to allocate/change Race Numbers as per rule 25.13.2.
- The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as per the 2011 AKA Manual.
- No refund of Entry Fee will be paid to any entrant who cancels their entry after close of entry.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

MINIMUM ENTRIES:

The minimum number of entries for Formula 100 Light and Formula 100 Heavy shall be 14.

The minimum number of entries for all other classes shall be ten.

If less than the minimum number of genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries then the Class will NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned.

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CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES:

All drivers must report to the Race Secretary to confirm their entry/s.

RACE NUMBERS:

Number 1 is reserved for current National Champions in Formula 100. Race numbers will be allocated when entries are received. Kart numbers are to be displayed on both right hand and left hand side pods.

TYRE POOLING:

All tyres for Championship classes and Feature classes will be available to be picked up at the completion of practise on Friday. All tyres must be fitted on rims and handed back into Parc Ferme prior to leaving the tyre impound area. This will make it easier for competitors to have tyres ready for qualifying on Saturday morning. This Friday afternoon tyre process will be conducted between 4.00 pm and 6.00pm. Competitors may elect to take their tyres on Saturday morning as well between the hours of 7.00am to 7.30am. All tyres on rims will be impounded on Saturday after final heat for the day in each feature class. At this time tyres will be impounded from karts after weighing and prior to karts leaving Parc Ferme area. No exceptions. It is the driver's responsibility to collect his/her tyres between the stated hours.

Any deterioration to the control markings on the tyres, after fitting tyres, must be reported to the scrutineer immediately for rectification.

Note: All competitors shall supply their own wet weather tyres and must present them for marking to the nominated area when directed.

FUEL:

Fuel as per 2011 AKA MANUAL. NO CONTROL FUEL. Fuel testing will be conducted.

TRACK CLOSURE:

Track will be closed from Monday 5th December through to Thursday 8th December, 2011.

Competitors may set up tents and equipment from 10:00 am Thursday 8th December, 2011.

SPONSOR STICKERS:

If requested, sponsors stickers supplied by the race organizers must be placed on all participating karts.

Twin Reed or Rotary Valve Air/water cooled 185kg

Engines Must be series production and AKA Homologated. Two stroke only with one

single throat carburettor per motor. Twin engines with a maximum total Cylinder volume of two times the relevant engine in the AKA manual. Four engines in total permitted to be used during the race meeting. Clutches and

Electric starters permitted.

Engines must conform to relevant motor chapter in 2011 AKA Manual

(Meaning must comply with their single engine class) Air boxes must be CIK approved. Auto chokes permitted. Exhaust systems must be AKA approved and can be modified for fitting to chassis. Class promoters reserve the right to adjust class weights if deemed necessary for safety etc. 125 engines permitted as per 2011 AKA Manual.
