- Entries for Open Performance Class must hold a minimum of an unrestricted B Grade Senior Licence.
- Refusal or acceptance of entries as per rule 1.15.
- The Race Secretary reserves the right to allocate/change Race Numbers as per rule 25.13.2.
- The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as per the 2011 AKA Manual.
- No refund of Entry Fee will be paid to any entrant who cancels their entry after close of entry.

PRIZES:

Trophies will be awarded as per Rule 20.33.

Blue Plates will be awarded to champions in all classes.

Trophies will be awarded for the Fastest Timed Qualifyer in each class.

FUEL:

The only fuels to be used at this meeting will be Mobil Premium Unleaded and must be purchased from Mobil Berrimah, Corner Stuart Highway & Berrimah Rd. Refer Rule 22.03.7.

Fuel must be purchased between Friday 8th and Sunday 10th July 2011 inclusive. Any pump may be used.

Random samples of competitor's fuel may be taken during the meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier on these dates.

Competitors are reminded that fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

TYRE POOLING:

Tyre pooling will be in effect at this meeting as per rule 23.11 of the AKA Manual.

Tyres will be distributed between 4:00 pm and 6.30pm on Thursday 7th July and 4:00 pm to 6.30pm on Friday 8th July from the Tyre Distribution area.

It is the driver's responsibility to collect his/her tyres between the stated hours.

Any deterioration to the control markings on the tyres, after fitting tyres, must be reported to the scrutineer immediately for rectification.

Note: All competitors shall supply their own wet weather tyres and must present them for marking to the nominated area when directed.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this race meeting will be as per rule 12.01 of the 2011 AKA Manual.

As per rule 1.16 of the AKA Manual, each kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the meeting. This signifies that the driver has confirmed their entry for the meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the entry.

From Saturday 9th July 2011, the Grid Marshall / Scrutineers shall not allow any kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to practice, time-qualify or race.

Failure to comply will result in the driver being excluded from the Meeting.

MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN LANE:

A Mechanical breakdown lane will be in use for this event.

BLUE AND RED DOUBLE DIAGONAL FLAG:

The blue and red double diagonal flag will be used during this meeting. Refer rule 15.13

As per rule 20.30 of the AKA Manual.

TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

As per rule 25.30 of the AKA Manual.

If required, AMB TRANX 160 transponder holder brackets will be available for purchase at the circuit at a cost of **\$10.00** inc. GST, all fitting screws and retaining clip included.

Darwin Karting Association will hold a very small number of spare transponders, available for <u>hire</u> in the event of emergency.

PIT SHELTERS:

Pit shelters are limited. Ample paddock space is available for entrants to erect there own shelters. If there is a requirement for shelter, contact the Race Secretary for assistance.

TRADE SPACE:

Trade will be allocated space in a designated trade area. This area is for trading only. Applications are to be made in writing via the Race Secretary; there will be no exceptions.

CANTEEN:

Ample pit area lighting exists. Limited electrical outlets are available on the perimeters of the pit area. Competitors may provide their own generator for lighting/power.

PARKING - CARS, VANS AND TRAILERS, ETC:

There will be no parking of vehicles on the premises. Any vehicles that will be used to pit from, will be parked in the designated area and will be there for the duration of the meeting. Exceptions are Club Officials, Race Officials, disabled and authorised vehicles only. There will be specified parking areas for these exceptions.

CYCLES IN THE VENUE:

There will be NO RIDING of push cycles, scooters, motorised scooters, skate-boards, mini-bikes or similar apparatus in the grounds at any time (Officials and disabled persons exempt). Any person or persons found riding or operating any apparatus within the grounds, will have the apparatus confiscated and it will not be returned until the completion of the meeting.

ANIMALS IN PITS:

Animals are prohibited with the exception of nominated Caretaker and Security company's guard dogs.

CAMPING:

Camping at the venue is prohibited.

Preamble

The Open Class was conceived to be a high performance class with very basic rules and is based on the Open Performance Class (Chapter 42) of the 2011 AKA Rulebook. The AKA (NT) created the class allowing a range of engine categories, each category having a weight which has been selected with the goal of creating a similar overall kart performance for each engine category over a range of circuits.

It is permissible to change engine category (and hence adjust to appropriate weight) during a race day, but stewards must be advised so weigh marshals are aware of the appropriate weight.

In keeping with the very basics, it was our intention that we have a class that required the minimum of regulations and engine measuring, essentially being that if the kart:

- ♦ conforms to Chapter 25. Australia Kart Formula,
- ♦ is within the weights (see below),
- ♦ and the engine is within the capacity limits as specified for it(s) engine category (see below),
- ♦ and the engines for the 125cc Gearbox conform to Chapter 43 of the 2011 AKA Rulebook, then it is eligible.

Driver Limitations

To be eligible to compete in this class, a competitor must hold a minimum of an AKA B Grade license.

Engine Eligibility (where not otherwise mentioned in this annex)

As per Chapter 42 (Rule 42.02)

Capacities, Weights and Specifications

The following are the maximum capacities and minimum weights for each type of eligible engine:

- 1. Piston ported engines 125 cc 130 kg (Engines must conform to specifications as outlined in Chapter 41)
- Pre 1998 CIK style Reed or Rotary 103 cc 140 kg (Engines must conform to specifications as outlined in Chapter 41)
- 3. CIK style Reed or Rotary 100 cc 103 cc 150 kg (Engines must conform to specifications as outlined in Chapter 41)
- 4. 106 to 135 cc reed, rotary or piston port engines 141 cc 150 kg
- 5. Up to 135 cc derived from KF series engines 135 cc 160 kg $\,$
- 6. Rotax Max DD2 141 cc 175 kg
- 7. Twin Clubman (engines must conform to Chapter 34)206 cc 170 kg
- 8. Twin engine (reed, rotary, piston port or modified Clubman) 210 cc 180 kg
- 9. Twin engine (reed or rotary valve water cooled) 210 cc 185 kg
- 10. Biland 4 stroke 250 cc 155 kg
- 11. 125 Gearbox (motocross style engines) 128 cc 175 kg
- 12. Twin 125 TAG engines (as per Chapter 42.03(2), Engines must conform to the appropriate 2011 Technical Document available from www.karting.net.au) 255 cc 185 kg
- 13. KZ2 (engines as per Technical Document TDKZ2, Section 43.6) 128 cc 180 kg

REMINDER – it is a KZ2 competitor's responsibility to have at all times a copy of the homologation documents relating to the engine and exhaust in use by the competitor. It is advisable that a copy of the documents be provided to the AKA/IKC for reference. If upon technical inspection the competitor cannot supply the documents for inspection and/or a copy is not in the possession of the AKA, the engine shall be deemed ineligible for competition/practice and the competitor shall be removed from any competition results, the competitor shall take no further part in the competition/practise and may face further action by the stewards.

Tyres

- 1. Dry weather tyres Dunlop DDM.
- 2. Wet weather tyres- any <u>AKA or CIK Group 2</u> wet tyre.
- 3. Bead retention optional, but compulsory on all karts with a combined (kart & weight) of above 170kg.

Carburettor

One single throat carburettor per cylinder

Ignition System

Digital ignition systems are allowed, if fitted to the engine originally by the manufacturer and are of the same type and style as originally fitted, otherwise only analogue type ignition systems are permitted.

Braking

Front wheel brakes may be used and are compulsory on all karts with a combined (kart & driver) weight of above 170kg.
