If there are insufficient entries to constitute a class by the listed close of entries then the class will NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any class shall be notified as soon as possible and the entry fee will be returned. Rule 20.28(d)

Minimum Licence – AKA A, B or C grade license holders are eligible to enter.

(Provisional D grade drivers are not eligible)

If less than 8 entries are received then that class will be withdrawn and entry fee returned.

FORMAT OF RACING - Method of Racing:

1. UNDERSUBSCRIBED CLASSES:

- a) 2 x 4 minute timed qualifying sessions.
- b) Heat one, **9 laps** Grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on)
 - Heat two, **9 laps** Grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on)
- c) One (1) Pre- final, **14 laps** Lowest points from heats one and two to Grid One, and so on.
- d) One (1) Final, **20 laps** The finishing order from Pre-Final to Grid 1, and so on, non finishers in the pre final will be gridded at the rear of the field in order of laps completed, then grid position from pre final.
- (e) All competitors must register a qualifying time and compete in the first heat to be eligible for grid positions for the Pre-Final and the Final.
- (f) Karts underweight will be excluded (refer R5.03.2) except during timed qualifying then R16.05(e) applies
- (g) Ties between karts on points from heats will be decided by qualifying position.
- (h) Point Score System for Heats:

1st - 0 Points

2nd - 2 Points

3rd - 3 Points and so on with one point being added for each place.

(i) Non-starters and non-finishers to be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed, then the grid position awarded from the start of the heat.

Finishing order of the final determines the winning positions in each Championship Class

2. OVER-SUBSCRIBED CLASSES:

(a) 2 x 4 minute timed Qualifying Sessions. After timed qualifying, all but the last five (5) grid positions are filled immediately for the heats. The last five (5) positions for the heats are filled from the results of the REPECHARGE RACE between the remainder of the competitors, up to track capacity.

- (b) One (1) Repecharge **9 laps** grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on)
- (c) Heat 1, **9 laps** grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on) including first five place getters from repercharge
 - Heat 2, **9 laps** grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on) including first five place getters from repechage.
- (d) One (1) Pre-Final, **14 laps** Lowest points from heats 1 and 2 to grid 1, and so on.
- (e) One (1) Final, **20 laps** The finishing order from Pre-Final to grid 1, and so on. Non finishers in the pre final will be gridded at the rear of the field in order of laps completed, then grid position from pre final.

3.

- (a) All competitors must register a qualifying time and compete in the first heat to be eligible for grid positions for the Pre-Final and final.
- (b) Karts underweight will be excluded (refer R 5.03.2) except during timed qualifying when R16.05(e) applies.
- (c) Ties between karts on points from heats will be decided by qualifying position.
- (d) Point Score System for Heats:

1st - 0 Points

2nd - 2 Points

3rd - 3 Points and so on with one point being added for each place.

(e) Non-starters and non-finishers to be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed, then the grid position awarded from the start of the heat.
 Drivers excluded during qualifying will be allocated the slowest time plus 1 second or as determined by the officials. Drivers disqualified during any race will be allocated points penalties as determined by the officials.

Finishing Order of the final determines the winning positions in each Championship Class.

Mechanical Breakdown Lane:

The mechanical breakdown lane will not be in use.

Blue and Red double diagonal Flag:

The blue and red double diagonal flag will be used during this meeting. Refer Rule 15.13

Abandonment or Postponement

The organisers reserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s) subject to Rule 1.25

Trophies:

Plagues will be awarded to the Fastest Time Qualifier in each class.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th & 5th place will be presented.

Blue number plate will be awarded to the 1st place getter only.

Insurance:

Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with Chapter 3.

Noise Levels: Maximum permissible noise levels shall be in accordance with Chapter 24

Fuel: As per the 2011 AKA Karting Manual.

The Controlled fuel for use during this meeting is **Shell Premium Unleaded, from Shell Service Station City bound side of freeway, Todd Road, Port Melbourne.** Fuel may be purchased from Wednesday 9th
March, 2011 **BUT** the control fuel must be used from Friday 11th March 2011 through to Sunday 13th March 2011 inclusive.

Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during this meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier between these dates.

REMINDER: Fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

Timing for Qualifying and Lap Scoring.

AMB TranX 160 transponders must be mounted in an appropriate bracket on the side pod of the kart, no more than 30cm above the track surface and approximately 30cm behind the king pin line of the front of the kart. It is recommended that the transponder is mounted vertically and there be no metal or carbon fibre between the bottom of the transponder and the track surface.

Competitors will be responsible at all times and for the correct fitting (rule 25.30) and maintenance of the transponder in all sections of the event contested. Competitors who fail to comply with this rule will be automatically excluded from that section of the event to which the offence relates, unless rule 16.05 (d) applies, or, the fault is with the organisers of the event. Action will be taken by the issue of a Penalty Notification Form which will be issued without an Officials Hearing and signed by at least one Steward and the Chief Timing Officer (Judge of Fact)

If the Transponder fails during the competition due to a technical fault as a result of 'Force Majeure', a Judge of Fact will take effect.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

As per rule 1.30.9 of the 2011 AKA Manual.

All motors must be fitted with solid sealing nuts appropriate for the respective type of engine unless specifically noted in class regulations. A maximum of one nut must be used per stud. A Sealing Nut is an extended head, cylinder or exhaust nut that has a minimum 3mm hole through one end that will allow the fitting of an engine seal/tag. The nut must not be able to turn or be removed once fitted with a seal.

As per rule 1.30.10 of the 2011 AKA Manual,

- a) All engines must have provision for sealing in accordance with rule 1.30.9
- b) AKA bar coded engine seals and chassis tags to be supplied, fitted and recorded by officials of the meeting prior to commencement of competition.
- c) It is the competitors responsibility to check their engine seals and chassis tags for loss or damage prior to leaving the in grid / scales area after each event.
- d) Competitor shall be deemed not to have fulfilled their duty to manage their seals / tags should there be a loss or damage to after leaving the in-grid / scales area after each event, or failure to produce the correct seals / tags when requested.
- e) Tails on plastic seals to be left at full length.

Pit crew attire - Rule 14 .12 ,1.05 : All pit crew shall be required to wear suitable attire, including shoes, and observe any other requirements on protective clothing in these rules.

Trailers / Cars: No Vehicles are permitted in the Pit Area.

No Trailers in the Pit area.

Pit space 6m x 3m and 3 x 3 only

All vehicles and trailers are to be parked in the designated parking

areas allocated.

No roping off -Pit Allocation by Pit Marshalls only

Pits will be closed at 6.30pm each night

GENERAL INFORMATION:

No animals allowed. No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit. No motorised scooters, scooters, mini bikes, bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.
