Minimum Entries - 8 genuine entries

If there are insufficient entries to constitute a class by the listed close of entries then the class will NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any class shall be notified as soon as possible and the entry fee will be returned. Rule 20.28(d)

Minimum Licence - AKA A, B or C grade license holders are eligible to enter. (Provisional D grade drivers are not eligible)

#### **ENTRIES**

Entry Fee - The entry fee per kart, per class, (includes all levies & GST) plus a relevant set of tyres is; LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Entry fee - will only be returned if notified in writing to the VKA of cancellation 48 hours prior to the event. Tyres fee will not be refunded and tyres MUST be collected at the end of the meeting.

Fuel: As per the 2012 AKA Karting Manual.

The Controlled fuel for use during this meeting is BP Service Station corner Princes Highway and Station Street, Corio. Fuel may be purchased from Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 **BUT** the control fuel must be used from Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2012 through to Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2012 inclusive.

Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during this meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier between these dates.

REMINDER: Fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

**Judges of Fact**: As per rule 4.17

#### **ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:**

As per rule 1.30.9 of the 2012 AKA Manual.

All motors must be fitted with solid sealing nuts appropriate for the respective type of engine unless specifically noted in class regulations. A maximum of one nut must be used per stud. A Sealing Nut is an extended head, cylinder or exhaust nut that has a minimum 3mm hole through one end that will allow the fitting of an engine seal/tag. The nut must not be able to turn or be removed once fitted with a seal. As per rule 1.30.10 of the 2012 AKA Manual,

- a) All engines must have provision for sealing in accordance with rule 1.30.9
- b) AKA bar coded engine seals and chassis tags to be supplied, fitted and recorded by officials of the meeting prior to commencement of competition.
- c) It is the competitors responsibility to check their engine seals and chassis tags for loss or damage prior to leaving the in grid / scales area after each event.
- d) Competitor shall be deemed not to have fulfilled their duty to manage their seals / tags should there be a loss or damage to after leaving the in-grid / scales area after each event, or failure to produce the correct seals / tags when requested.
- e) Tails on plastic seals to be left at full length.

#### **Tyre Pooling:**

Tyre Pooling will occur at this meeting as per R23.11.

Tyres will be available at the designated times as laid out in the timetable or as notified over the public address system. It is the drivers responsibility to collect his/her tyres between the stated times.

All tyres supplied by the promoting club will be scanned with the bar code scanning system or marked with the race number and class they are to be used in, prior to the start of competition for the race meeting.

As per the 2012 manual it is the driver's responsibility to ensure that at least one bar code per tyre remains scannable at all times for the duration of the race meeting.

Note: All competitors shall supply their own wet weather tyres as per Rule 23.10 and must present them for marking to the nominated area when directed at tyre pooling.

<u>Pit crew attire</u> - Rule **14** .**12** ,**1.05** : All pit crew shall be required to wear suitable attire, including covered in shoes, and observe any other requirements on protective clothing in these rules.

**Trailers / Cars:** No Vehicles are permitted in the Pit Area. No Trailers in the Pit area.

All vehicles and trailers are to be parked in the designated parking areas allocated.

Pit space 6m x 3m and 3m x 3m only

No roping off –Pit Allocation by Pit Marshalls only

OVERSIZED TRAILERS WILL BE PARKED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE GEELONG KART CLUB.

Pits will be closed at 6.30pm each night
