The following rule deletion has been approved by an NKC postal vote (PV2011-06).

Delete rule 6.02.2 from the 2011 AKA Manual.

6.02.2 Revise finishing order.

A revision of the finishing order of a race may be imposed when the Stewards deem a competitor has gained an unfair advantage, or unfairly disadvantaged other competitor/s. Generally used when the finishing order determines a grid position or placing with no points attached (pre-final or final only counts). Succeeding competitors affected by the revised finishing order will receive the entitlements associated with their revised placing. When circumstances permit, revision of the finishing order of a race may also permit the reinstatement of unfairly disadvantaged competitors.

- There are many and varied scenarios, both positive and negative, where this rule can be, or should not be applied.
- It is the duty of all AKA Licenced Officials to **only** use this rule “when circumstances permit” or during the application of a penalty of revision of the finishing order of a race.
