Background

Rule 13.19 c) has been adjusted to permit a driver wishing to compete in Junior Clubman, Formula JMax, Junior Performance and KF3 to compete in the year in which they will be turning 13 years of age. There are certain restrictions that may be applied to such drivers until their 13th birthday.

This Procedure establishes and clarifies the procedures to follow in implementing this Rule.

Rule 13.19 c

(iv) A Driver may compete in Junior Clubman, Formula JMax, Junior Performance or KF3 in the year of their (13th) birthday providing they meet the following criteria;

- Hold a Minimum of a B Grade licence for the past twelve (12) months
- Be a current holder of a Junior Licence
- Display a Green P Plate on the rear of their Kart until their thirteenth (13th) birthday.

The Drivers will be observed by the Clerk of the Course and/or Chief Steward and will start at the rear of the Field in all Events until these Officials are satisfied with the performance of the Driver or the Driver attains the age of thirteen (13) years.

Eligibility to compete in these Classes shall be revoked if a Driver, in the view of the Chief Steward and the Clerk of the Course is deemed to have insufficient driving ability for the Class.

Procedure

- During the course of the meeting the competitor shall be observed to confirm that they have the required abilities to compete satisfactorily in the field.
- At the conclusion of the meeting if the Clerk of Course and/or Chief Steward observes satisfactory performance, a notation is placed on the licence in CMS indicating such and the driver may start the next race meeting in the appropriate grid be that drawn or based on qualified position whilst displaying a Green P Plate.

The driver should not be granted permission to advance in the grid during a race meeting.

This notation is valid for the next race meeting and thereafter until such time as the driver turns 13 or the notation is revoked by a Clerk of Course and/or Chief Steward.
