The information and specifications contained in this Homologation and Technical Specification Update Bulletin are to be read in conjunction with and form part of the homologation detailed herein.

EXPLANATORY NOTES SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER'S REPRESENTATIVE.

Chain guard accessory: Prevents intrusion of body parts (e.g. fingers, hands, elbows) where the manner of engine mounting leaves unrestricted access to the drive sprocket.

Function: The Safety guard has 3 primary functions: 1) Prevent accidental contact of rotating assembly
2) Provide air flow for cooling of clutch
3) Allow easy access for maintenance or repair

Rational: High impact polycarbonate material provides a safety guard that is both durable and flexible. Allowing for maximum ease of engine position, as it will deform to accommodate close proximity to seats and or mounting struts.

- Increased personal safety, (maintains separation of moving parts from the driver)
- Ease of engine installation and clutch maintenance
- Will not become damaged or unsafe during normal operation
