Background

Due to freight delays caused by the Covid-19 Pandemic, there was a shortage of wet weather tyres used in the Cadet 9, Cadet 12 and KA4 Classes in Australia.

These freight delays have now been overcome and the TCRA issued on 14 July, 2021 has now been rescinded **WITH EFFECT FOR ALL EVENTS HELD AFTER 1 SEPTEMBER 2021.**
